Rockville, MD – AWLAN, an Rockville Innovation Center company focused on the design, installation and maintenance of medium to large scale wireless local area networks today announced that it was hired to design, install and maintain The Crystal City Business Improvement District (BID) free, outdoor, wireless Internet (Wi-Fi®) service, creating a wireless Hotzone throughout Crystal City's courtyards and green spaces. A Wi-Fi Hotzone is a large scale Wi-Fi Hotspot that spans several blocks utilizing wireless mesh technology.

"With convenient access to the Airport, Metro, VRE, area bike trails, and roadways, Crystal City has long been known for its accessibility," said Angela Fox, President/CEO of the Crystal City BID. "Crystal Wi-Fi adds a new dimension to this strategic neighborhood advantage by making it easy for Crystal City's residents, workers, and visitors to ACCESS the world and stay connected while enjoying Crystal City's many beautiful green spaces and wonderful outdoor dining options."

The service is provided through a creative partnership whereby Atlantech Online provides the broadband access, the Crystal City BID provides the end-user wireless connection to the Internet, Vornado/Charles E. Smith provides rooftops for antennae installation, and AWLAN provides the turnkey wireless LAN installation and maintenance specifically designed for PDA, laptop and mobile users.

"We are proud to be a partner in this significant technology project," says Jonathan Walker, P.E., CEO of AWLAN. "This new wireless network has provided us with the opportunity to showcase wireless mesh technology which provides end-users with the ability to roam freely while remaining connected to high-speed wireless Internet access. The new Wi-Fi network is accessible in the following locations:

Crystal Drive - Sidewalks: From dining and retail establishments on 18th Street, and south to 23rd Street.

Bell Street Courtyard: Home to the popular Crystal Screen movie festival every summer. Wi-Fi access will allow this year's movie-goers to browse the web while picnicking before the movies begin. This Courtyard is located between 20th and 18th Street along S. Bell Street diagonal to the Crystal City Metro.

2001 Jefferson Davis Highway Plaza: This expansive plaza area, which will host Vintage Crystal in September, centers around several office and residential buildings, including the newest 220 20th Street.

Courtyard @ 2121 Crystal Drive: The large courtyard park space in front of 2121 Crystal Drive located between 20th and 23rd Street is an outdoor escape for area employees.

Courtyard @ 2345 Crystal Drive: The beautifully landscaped courtyard located near 23rd Street and in front of 2345 Crystal Drive (Park 4) is a Crystal Wi-Fi hot zone and a busy location for Bocci pick-up games.

The New Century Center Streetscape @ 2450 Crystal Drive: As part of a \$25 million redevelopment, Lowe Enterprises Real Estate Group created a new retail streetscape along Crystal Drive. Sitting areas along the wide, pedestrian-friendly sidewalk now has Crystal Wi-Fi access maintained by AWLAN.

Bright Horizons Park & Volleyball Courts: The small plaza just south of the Bright Horizons - Crystal City which has tables, chairs, and shade trees as well as volleyball courts is part of the Crystal Wi-Fi hot zone.
